- 1. We, the Recognition Partners, have identified the potential benefits of achieving Internal (One-Way) Recognition of **DGAM** by the **UAE MAA**.
- 2. Any national legal and policy considerations that maybe binding upon us have been assessed. There are nil national regulatory and/or legal requirements that impact or impede this Recognition.
- 3. We, the Recognition Partners, have agreed the scope of Recognition review will be as prescribed in EMAD R Edition 2.0 Annex D MARQ Sub-Section A Airworthiness Authority Goals.
- The Recognition review process detailed in EMAD R Edition 2.0 has been followed and confidence has been established that DGAM's airworthiness assurance and regulatory approach is acceptable to the UAE MAA.
- 5. **DGAM**'s conduct of regulatory assurance is assessed as being at a standard by which the airworthiness authority artefacts can be accepted by **UAE MAA** as described in the table below.

Artefacts	Remarks
DGAM developed and/or approved Instruments of Airworthiness can be accepted by UAE MAA .	Artefacts shall be based on EMARs or equivalent national regulations; and satisfy EMAD R MARQ Sub-Section A requirements.

- 6. This Recognition Certificate is valid for 4 years from the date of signature on the cover.
- 7. This Recognition Certificate will be reviewed at least 6 months before the end date of its validity unless any significant changes to the Authorities occurs before that date.
- 8. **DGAM** undertakes to inform **UAE MAA** immediately of any significant changes in accordance with Step 18 of EMAD R.
- 9. DGAM undertakes to provide necessary Instruments of Airworthiness to UAE MAA, preferably in English language, for all initial approvals and on-going surveillance activities accepted and/or to be accepted by DGAM for all organizations that are declared to be in the interest of the UAE MAA.
- 10. **DGAM** undertakes to inform **UAE MAA** in a timely manner of any concerns they may have relating to the performance of Organisations for which the **DGAM** has issued approvals, certificates, licenses and reports of which have been adopted and/or accepted by the **UAE MAA**.
- 11. The essential principle that recognition is a national responsibility is maintained, hence sovereign regulatory responsibility is not abdicated by issuance of this certificate.
